General Information and Policies

La Copa San Diego Omnium is sanctioned by USA Cycling and hosted in partnership with San Diego Bicycling Club and Padyak Racing Team. All participants are expected to follow the guidelines outlined below to ensure a safe, fair, and enjoyable event for all racers, staff, and spectators. We're thrilled to host this omnium weekend featuring two closed-road events:

- **Saturday: Criterium (Barrio Logan Grand Prix)**

 **Address:** 1824 Newton Ave, San Diego, CA 92113


 **Directions:** From I-5, exit Cesar E. Chavez Parkway eastbound. Turn right on Main Street, then left on Newton Avenue. Registration and staging are near 1824 Newton Ave.

 **Parking:** Free parking at 1904 National Avenue, San Diego, CA 92113 about a 2-minute bike ride to registration and the course. Prefilled parking passes will be emailed to racers.

- **Sunday: Circuit Race near High Tech High in Eastlake**

 **Address:** 1945 Discovery Falls Dr, Chula Vista, CA 91915

 **Directions:** Exit 125 at Otay Lakes Rd, head east, then south on Eastlake Pkwy. Racers Village will be at the end of Eastlake Parkway and the beginning of Hunte Parkway.

- **Registration location: Corner of Hunte Parkway and Eastlake Parkway.**



Please pay close attention to all posted signage, course markings, and official announcements. Riders are responsible for knowing the course and must attend their staging call at least **10 minutes before** the start of their race.

Parking: Parking will be available near each venue. DO NOT park in private business lots or unmarked areas. Respect local regulations and signage. Violators may be towed and/or disqualified from the race. Some parking is available on Eastlake Parkway North between Stylus and Crossroads.

Team Canopy Access (Sunday only): Team village entrance is located at the intersection of Eastlake Parkway and Hunte Parkway. Teams must have an email confirmation from the race organizers to set up a canopy for **Sunday only**.

Restrooms: Portable toilets will be provided at both venues. DO NOT relieve yourself in public or off course. Disrespecting the venue in this way is grounds for **immediate disqualification**.

Stage Awards

- Saturday: Awards administered by San Diego Bicycling Club
- Sunday: Medals awarded to the top 3 finishers per category



Sunday P123 Cash Purse Payout for Overall Omnium top 6

- Men P123 – \$1,500
- Women P123 – \$1,500

Payout Structure:

- 1st – \$500
- 2nd – \$300
- 3rd – \$250
- 4th – \$200
- 5th – \$150
- 6th – \$100

Top 6 will report to the podium for payout confirmation.

Prize amounts may be adjusted proportionally based on field size.

Omnium General Classification (GC) Awards:

- Medals awarded to top 3 overall
- Leader jersey awarded to overall Omnium winners

Overall Omnium awards will be presented Sunday following the Circuit Race.

GC Tie Breaker: In the event of a tie in General Classification standings, the finish order from the **most recent stage** will be used per USAC Rule 3H4(g)(ii).

Podiums: The top 5 finishers in each race must report to the podium immediately after their finish for awards and photos. Podium presentations will take place immediately after results are posted on **ontheday.net**. Primes may also be collected during podium presentations at the corner of Eastlake Parkway and Hunte Parkway.

Registration & Waivers: All participants must register online via BikeReg. By doing so, you sign the USAC waiver electronically and **do not** need to sign a paper waiver at check-in.

Race Cancellation Policy: If the event is canceled due to weather or other uncontrollable circumstances, entry fees will be rolled over to a future event.

Rider Conduct & Safety All riders must conduct themselves with courtesy and sportsmanship. Helmets must be worn and fastened at all times. Obey course officials, stay alert, and race safe. Riders under 18 and **all children riding bikes at either venue**—including those participating in the Community Bike Race—**must wear helmets at all times.**

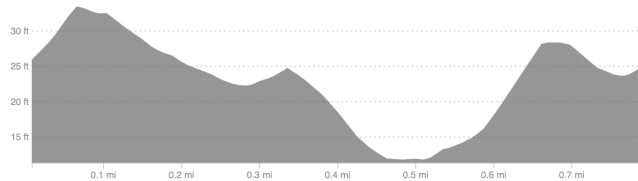

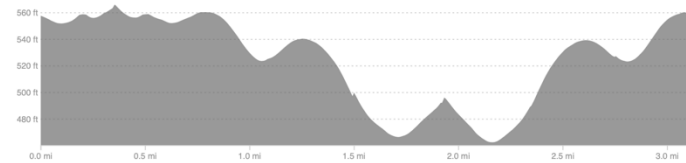

Number Placement



Rider Numbers

- **Saturday Criterium:** Riders are required to wear **one bib number**, placed on the **left** side of the jersey. Ensure the number is clearly visible to officials and finish line cameras.
- **Sunday Road Race:** All riders must wear **two bib numbers** as per USA Cycling regulations. Numbers must be placed on the **left and right side of the jersey**, clearly visible and not obstructed by hair, hydration packs, or other equipment.

Numbers must be securely fastened at all four corners, laid flat, and not folded or crinkled. Wrinkled, obscured, or improperly placed numbers may result in penalties in accordance with USA Cycling rules.

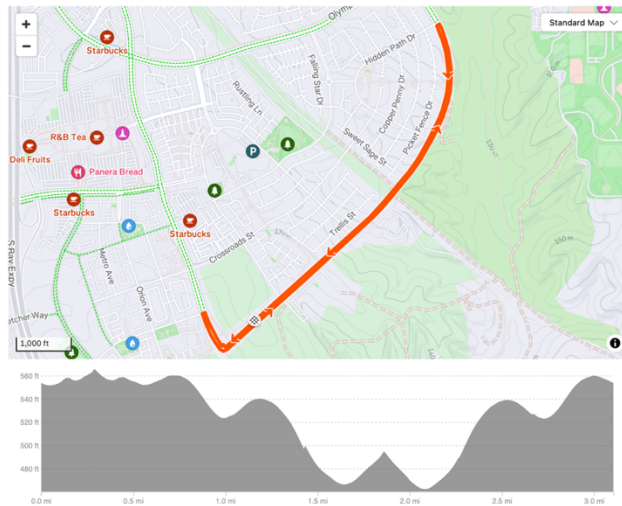

USA CYCLING'S SAFE SPORT PROTOCOL

Padyak Racing Team supports USA Cycling's mission of ensuring a safe and enjoyable cycling environment for all and will be following the mandates of the U.S. Center of SafeSport and USA Cycling's Safe Sport Program.

To help create a safe environment that is free from misconduct and abuse at all USA Cycling events, please review USA Cycling's Safe Sport Program Policies, including reporting requirements and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP). All Omnium participants must abide by these policies.

PROHIBITED CONDUCT: All participants at this event are expected to refrain from engaging in Prohibited Conduct as defined by the US Center for SafeSport Code. Prohibited Conduct includes but is not limited to the following: sexual misconduct, emotional misconduct, physical misconduct, bullying, harassment, hazing, and violations of the MAAPP.

MAAPP: These policies have been adopted by USA Cycling to establish clear boundaries between participants in cycling and to reduce isolated one-on-one interactions between minors and adults in cycling and apply during all USA Cycling events, including before, during, and returning from the event: One-on-One Interactions; Meeting & Training Sessions; Athletic Training Modalities; Locker Rooms; Transportation; Lodging; Electronic Communications.

REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: Adult Participants are required to report violations of USA Cycling's Safe Sport Program, including violations of the MAAPP. The mandatory reporting requirements apply to Adult Participants, but USA Cycling encourages anyone who becomes aware of, or experiences misconduct or abuse, to report those allegations. While USA Cycling is committed to providing a safe environment for all participants, the organization can't address behaviors or problems it is unaware of, so your engagement in reporting is instrumental in ensuring safety for all.
